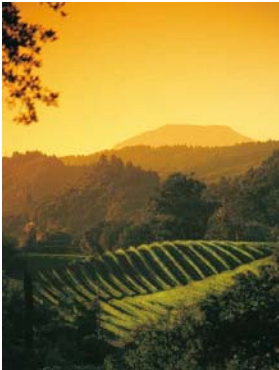

California is the largest producer of wine of any state in the USA. Each year, it produces millions of liters of quality vintage wines. The best-known wine growing region in the state is Napa Valley, located about 50 miles north of San Francisco.

Napa Valley stretches about 35 miles northward along Route 29. In most parts, it is only a few miles wide with low volcanic hills defining its sides. The flat valley floor and the surrounding hillsides are covered with orchards and vineyards. Small towns and villages like Napa, Yountville, Rutherford and Calistoga are set amidst the quaint farmlands. Signs near every intersection invite you to visit famous wineries. Some of the

wineries are located in small farms, others are in beautiful estates with palatial mansions and others are in Victorian houses or even in European-style castles.

Doubly blessed with rich volcanic soil and an ideal varied climate, Napa Valley is optimally suited to produce world quality wine grapes. Wherever you travel in this scenic area, you are almost always in view of a vine-covered mountain or valley, and no matter the time of year, you're in for a treat for all the senses.
