

2008 Oil Company Tier II Compliance Has March 1 Deadline

Petroleum bulk plants, marinas and fleet fueling facilities that stored more than 10,000 pounds of hazardous chemicals (including gasoline, diesel fuel, kerosene, heating oil, propane, aviation fuels, etc.) at any time during the 2007 calendar year must file Tier II reports in compliance with the EMERGENCY PLANNING AND COMMUNITY RIGHT-TO-KNOW ACT (EPCRA). These reporting requirements only apply to stationary storage; trucks do not count toward the aggregate. Reports must be filed by March 1 with local/state emergency response authorities.

Note that oil trucks do not count towards the compliance threshold.

Reports must be filed by **March 1, 2008** with local/state emergency response authorities.
